ARRIVAL & CHECK-IN

- 1** Temporarily unload your group's gear along S. King Street.
- 2** Park in the adjacent lot, street parking, or nearby free parking garage. (Do not park in private spaces. Vehicles will be towed.)
- 3** Enter using the Scout entrance on the S. King St. side of the lobby. Do not use the front main entrance.
- 4** Place all gear along the designated lobby wall. Do not block doors, walkways, or emergency exits.
- 5** Group leader will check in the entire group at the check-in table.
- 6** Sleeping gear may be set up in designated area **AFTER 9:00 PM.**

SUPERVISION

Adult leaders, parents, and chaperones are responsible for the supervision of all minors at all times.



FOOD & DRINK

Snacks are permitted only in the Cafe and lobby areas. No food or drinks are allowed near exhibits.



OVERNIGHT ACCESS

Doors are locked during the Camp-In. If you need to exit (non-emergency), use the employee doors and notify security guard.
